HOW TO HIT

The lob shot is a high floating shot that rolls very little when it lands on the green. It's fun to play a lob shot, however a really high shot is seldom necessary on the golf course and should rarely be used. The proper strategy on the course is to always hit the ball as low as possible, therefore, you only want to hit the high lob when you have no green to work with and you absolutely must get the ball close to the hole.
